

Installation Procedure

- System Requirements :

PHP 5.3.5, Apache 2.2.17


- Download Community Edition Zip file. Unzip it in www folder in your apache server.

Two folders are available namely

- 1) install
- 2) web_school

Run the 'install' folder on your browser.

- Steps for installation:

Now you have to set the path name for webschool. Open web_school folder → inc folder → functions.php file.

Edit the following marked in **red**, if the path is different from the one mentioned below:

Line2 → define("SITE_URL", "**http://localhost/communityedition/web_school/**");

Line3 → define("VIEW_SITE_URL", "**http://localhost/communityedition/web_school/view/**");
